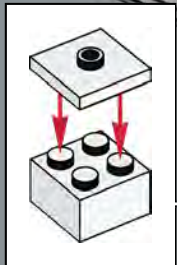


The sabre-toothed tiger skull is another prized artifact in the natural history collection. Did you know that their oversized canine teeth could measure up to 20 cm (7.8 in.) long?



Yes, this is, in fact, dino poo. Fossilised dinosaur waste (coprolite) can actually tell us a lot about a species' diet. The Brachiosaurus, for example, was strictly vegetarian.

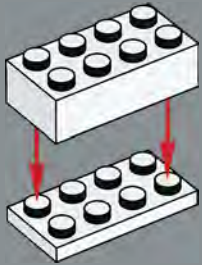


Volcanoes are typically found over mantle plumes and meeting points of tectonic plates. Don't worry, this model of an active volcano is completely safe to explore.

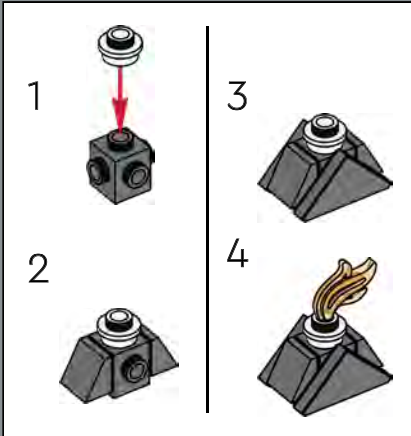
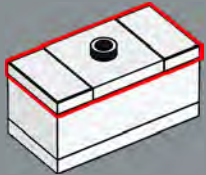
